Regular Season

This will consist of an even number of home and away games depending upon your division. It is suggested that you should book the games with the largest amount of travel time first. Post Season

The teams will be broken into Championship brackets with each team guaranteed seven post season games. These Championship brackets will be determined by winning percentage based on the following criteria.

Seating:

1. Winning Percentage
2. Head to Head
3. Goals Against
4. Goal Differential

Semi:

We will be re-seeding the playoffs after the Post Season based upon the results of these games for the Semifinal.

Home Team:

The home teams will be the 1 and 2 seed after re-seeding has taken place. They will be the host of the Semi Final games and the away team is responsible for the cost of the officials for those games. The higher seed will be the home team for the Championship game.

Game Time Frames:

Mite's & Squirt's-The length of periods will be 10 minute stop time.

Pee Wee's & Bantam's -The length of periods will be 12 minute stop time.

JV -The length of periods will be 15 minute stop time.

All Semifinal Game Sheets:

Squirt's-1 hr. and 15 min.

Pee Wee's & Bantam's -1 hr. and 30 min.

JV -1 hr. and 30 min

Championship/Semi Final Tie Breaker System

Tie Procedure:

1. (5) Minute sudden death overtime period will be played provided there is more than (8) minutes left on the curfew clock. The teams will not change ends.
2. A Shootout consisting of (5) players from each team alternately taking penalty shots. A coin toss will determine which team will shoot first. If after (5) players from both teams have completed the procedure, the tie has not been broken. The process will continue in a sudden death mode with one shooter from each team other than those that have already participated until the ice time runs out. Each team will be given an opportunity to shoot in each of the sudden death rounds.

8U Hockey Season

Half Ice League: Season starts as October 1, 2019

- Complete teams 10 to 13 players.
- 2008/2009 birth years.
- 16 games from October to March.
- Standing, goals for and against tracked online.
- Top teams face off in second half of the year for playoffs and championship. Playoffs can be for all teams' top teams from different divisions competing for championship.
- Games are three 10-minute periods.
- Mandatory half ice Nets
- Mandatory full half ice boards
- If puck is frozen, the ref will whistle the play dead and the puck is given to the defensive team.
- Face offs at center ice for return to play after stop times, when goals are scored, when penalties are called.
- Penalties are served by the player being sent immediately to their bench for the remainder of their shift.
- 2 minute stop times for shift changes.
- Running clock for the 2 minute shift with a puck drop
- 4 on 4 with two goalies.
- Scores posted on scoreboards.
- USA Hockey Refs will be used.
- USA Hockey Rosters will be used.

The idea is to form a league that is similar to full ice with teams rostered, and a complete league with standing, scores, playoffs, etc.
